

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-09-26

AN ORDINANCE OF MARIES COUNTY, MISSOURI, TO REPEAL THE EXISTING ORDINANCE GOVERNING ON-SITE WASTEWATER DISPOSAL SYSTEMS IN AREAS OF MARIES COUNTY, MISSOURI, NOT ON PUBLIC SYSTEM ADOPTED BY THE MARIES COUNTY COMMISSION ON MARCH 23, 1998

Be it resolved by the Commissioners of the County of Maries as follows:


SECTION 1: Repeal an ordinance known as Maries County Ordinance Governing On-Site Wastewater Disposal Systems in Areas of Maries County, Missouri, Not on Public System, which was adopted by the Maries County Commission on March 23, 1998.

SECTION 2: REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are herein repealed.


SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4: WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication by law or on October 15, 2024, whichever comes later.
